

VOLUNTEER POSITION DESCRIPTIONS

RACE SWEEPER

Sweeper's ride/run at the back of designated race category and tend to any issues which may arise on course. **Bike Race Sweepers must bring your own bike, helmet, and riding gear!**

COURSE MARSHAL

Course Marshals actively ensure safety by manning key locations along the course directing riders, warning riders of upcoming hazards, and providing rapid response to incidents.

COURSE/INFIELD SET-UP

Volunteer duties include race course & infield setup of fencing & other barriers, course tape, signs, flags, and sponsor banners.

COURSE TAKEDOWN

Upon race completion, volunteer's takedown, and cleanup the race course removing course tape, signs, flags, fencing, barriers, and race-related debris.

CROSSING GUARD

Crossing Guards protect racers by keeping course clear of spectators and vehicles without interfering with the athletes and the race.

REGISTRATION VOLUNTEER

Volunteers will assist at Registration Tent with greeting athletes, check-ins, packet pickup, merchandise sales, and general questions.

PARKING VOLUNTEER

Volunteers will direct parking, welcome athletes, and direct them to the Registration Tent.

START LINE VOLUNTEER

Assist with making sure athletes are at the start line for their respective wave times.

VOLUNTEER MANAGER

The volunteer assistant will manage volunteer sign-ins, direct volunteers to assigned locations, communicate shortages, and rebalance assignments if necessary.

BEVERAGE TENT VOLUNTEER

Assist with collecting tokens and pouring drinks, maintaining beverage supply from Vendor, and general cleanup of beverage tent. **Must be 18 years or older.**
